General Conditions & Requirements:

1. Postsecondary credit candidates must apply, be accepted, and enroll at the College for Creative Studies (CCS) to receive credit.
2. A maximum of 12 credits will be awarded through articulated Career and Technical Education (CTE) credit for students completing the full Fashion Design program at HSF1.
3. The CCS Office of Admissions reserves the right to apply credit toward the courses best suited to the student's needs. This is determined upon review of the student's portfolio but will include two (3 credit) courses in Fashion Design (FAD) and up to two Foundation (DFN) or Elective Credits.
4. Application for postsecondary credit must be completed and submitted by both the secondary CTE program representative and by the student within three years of the student's high school graduation.
5. Students must complete the full course of studies, earning a 'B' (3.0) or above in all CTE coursework to be guaranteed transfer of credit outlined.
6. Credit for courses outlined will only be awarded to students who enroll at CCS for a BFA in Fashion Design or Fashion Accessories Design. Students seeking other programs at CCS will have potential credit evaluated on a case-by-case basis.
7. Credit granted by CCS for CTE is not guaranteed to transfer to programs outside of CCS. Should students following this agreement seek to complete studies at another college or university after enrolling at CCS, the receiving institution will determine if the coursework outlined in this agreement will be accepted.
8. This agreement does not constitute a guarantee of admission, scholarship, financial aid, or eligibility for additional opportunities at CCS.

9. Students who do not:

- complete the full Fashion Design Program at HSF1
- earn a 3.0 in *all* CTE related coursework
- major in Fashion Design at CCS

may still be eligible for CTE credit. These students will be assessed on a case-by-case basis and are encouraged to complete the admissions process to determine potential credit.
